COST. Students who wish to participate in intramurals pay a fee of <u>\$40.00 per program</u> (checks made payable to the <u>Glenwood PTSA</u>), per student. Some sessions require additional fees based on the nature of the program, this is noted in the intramural description. This is a session-based fee, and monies are not compensated due to inclement weather days or other cancellations due to extenuating circumstances. Scholarships are available for those who need one, please contact Assistant Principal O'Byrne for more information. *Refunds will only be issued within one week of the intramural start date.*

TRANSPORTATION. Intramural programs will run from <u>2:25 to 3:25 PM</u> the specified day each week during the session. All students participating in intramurals need to prearrange their own transportation home from the intramural. If a student is continually picked up late from a session, they may not be allowed to continue participating in intramurals. You do not need to send in a note granting permission for your child to stay after school on the days they are signed up for an intramural. You may choose to allow your child to walk to the Glenwood Library/Glenwood Community Center after intramurals if a 3:25 pickup does not work for your family. Students may ride home with another parent if they have written permission from their parent/guardian.

OTHER INTRAMURAL POLICIES. Intramurals programs are not held on early dismissal days. Intramurals may be cancelled based on enrollment. Cancellations may also occur due to inclement weather or unavoidable emergencies. Any change in the schedule will be announced in advance during the school day. Due to this possibility, please make sure your child knows what plans he/she should follow to get home in case a cancellation occurs. Students should dress appropriately and are expected to follow school policies and procedures at all times. Program space is limited, and enrollment is mostly on a first come, first served basis with the exception of the Cooking with Italians intramural (see program for details.)
