6th Grade Student Orientation – Thursday, August 31 – 12:30 P.M. in Glenwood MS Cafeteria

Glenwood staff members will host an orientation session for 6th grade students on Thursday, August 31 at 12:30 P.M. Students should report to their homeroom **(see attached homeroom list)** at the start of the orientation. Any 7th or 8th grade student who is new to Glenwood can meet with his/her guidance counselor. They will receive basic information about Glenwood Middle School. Students will receive a tour, learn about the school, and follow their schedules.
