OVERVIEW. Intramurals will be offered for three nine-week sessions during the 2019-2020 school year. **Program times and dates will vary**, so please pay careful attention to program specifics when signing up in order to ensure the program times and days fit your schedule.

TRANSPORTATION. All students participating in intramurals need to prearrange their own transportation home from the intramural. If a student is continually picked up late from a session, they may not be allowed to continue participating in intramurals. You do not need to send in a note granting permission for your child to stay after school on the days they are signed up for an intramural. You may choose to allow your child to walk to the Glenwood Library/Glenwood Community Center after intramurals if pickup does not work for your family. Students may ride home with another parent if they have written permission from their parent/guardian.

OTHER INTRAMURAL POLICIES. Intramural programs are not held on early dismissal days. Intramurals may be cancelled based on enrollment. Cancellations may also occur due to inclement weather or unavoidable emergencies. Any change in the schedule will be announced in advance during the school day. Due to this possibility, please make sure your child knows what plans he/she should follow to get home in case a cancellation occurs. Students should dress appropriately and are expected to follow school policies and procedures at all times. Program space is limited, and enrollment is mostly on a first come, first served basis (see program for details).

Please note session times and dates in the program descriptions, as they vary.

Art Club with Mrs. Ludlow When: Thursdays Time: 2:30 - 3:30 Duration: Session 2 Location: Art Studio

Are you a morning person or are you always busy after school, but really need a little extra time/help with homework? In Start with Success students would receive individualized help preparing for upcoming tests and quizzes, reinforcing study skills, and homework support as needed.

<u>Chamber Orchestra</u> with Ms. Kim <u>When:</u> Tuesdays <u>Time:</u> 2:30 – 3:30 <u>Location:</u> Room 33

Can't get enough of orchestra and want to play more challenging repertoire? Want more performance opportunities? You've come to the right place! This audition-based orchestra will meet Tuesdays from 2:30-3:30 in the Orchestra Room, where we will be performing more advanced orchestral pieces that were originally composed for a smaller orchestra setting. The Chamber Orchestra will be performing in the Spring Concert as well as participating in Music in the Parks, which will be at Hershey Park this year.

<u>Math Coaching</u> <u>When:</u> Tuesdays <u>Time:</u> 2:30 - 3:30 <u>Location</u>: Based on coaching assignment

Students receive additional support with completing their math homework. Additional, related practice problems are provided should the assigned homework be completed prior to dismissal time. While <u>not</u> intended to replace one-to-one tutoring, mathematics teachers, through working with students towards homework completion, provide individual assistance. Be sure to sign up with a math teacher for your child's current course. Based upon enrollment, offerings may be adjusted. Sessions will meet in math classrooms. All Math Coaching offerings are **limited to 15 per program** in order to successfully meet the needs of the students enrolled.**Students will be placed in sections according to their math needs. Students will be provided with math coaching details once they have been placed.**

Top Chef 2020 with Mr. Lovera When: Thursdays Time: 2:30 – 4:30 Location: FACS room We are adding a twist to our 2019 Top Chef intramural. As with previous years, we are accepting 16 interested "chefs" to participate in our 9-week cooking class. The big difference is that this year we will not be competing. Instead, interested chefs will be asked to propose a favorite recipe. Along with the recipe, each chef will include an explanation as to how their suggestion is worthy of being selected as one of the nine recipes. Mr. Lovera will look over the proposals and select the top 9. Winning proposals will be led by the chef whose entry was selected for that week. Mr. Lovera will still be purchasing all the necessary ingredients for each session.

Cost of the intramural includes a \$45 food supplement.
