




First Day Procedures

Where does my child enter the building?

- Bus riders will enter through the main doors out front.
- Car riders will enter through the side doors at one of the student drop-off points.

Where do they go on the first day?

- All students should report directly to their homerooms after entering the building.
- Students may not enter the building before 7:25 on any school day unless they have a pass from a staff member.




Info for Car Riders

Enter at Old Bushy Park!


Please drive up to and around the blacktop when dropping your child off.

Students should only exit your car at one of the two drop off locations identified on the side of the building.

Be sure to watch for staff directing traffic when you exit the blacktop. You may be asked to stop and wait for students in the crosswalk and buses departing.

- Point of Sale System (POS)- students will use their codes from previous years
 - Copy of codes for students who forget
 - Cash will still be accepted throughout the school year
 - Payments can be made online through an app or students can bring in money to add to their account at:
 - Please keep track of account funds (My School Bucks can send you alerts!)
 - Turnover isn't immediate- fund take about 24 hours to post to the account.

LOCKERS

LOCKER: COMBINATION:

1. Start at 0. Turn dial RIGHT 3 whole turns until you reach the first number of the combination.



Turn dial LEFT one time past above number and continue until you reach the second number.



Turn dial RIGHT until you reach the third number holding the dial tightly. The lock will release automatically as you pull the dial.



Please memorize your number and keep your locker combination in a safe place.

DOES THE SCHOOL HAVE A DRESS CODE?

- Unduly exposes or reveals skin or undergarments.
- Causes or is likely to cause a substantial or material **disruption** to school activities or the orderly operation of the school.
- Depicts profanity, obscenity, the use of weapons, or violence.
- Promotes use of **tobacco**, **drugs**, **alcohol** products or implies or contains **sexually suggestive messages**
- Contains **rude**, **disrespectful**, or **discourteous** expressions inconsistent with civil discourse and behavior.



WHAT DO I DO IF MY CHILD IS LATE OR ABSENT?

- Ways to report an absence:
 - gmsabsence@hcpss.org (Be specific; name, grade, reason)
 - Use the link on our website to report an absence
 - A signed parent note or doctor note is required when the student returns for the absence to be excused.
- Late: Sign in your child at the Front Office with a note if they are late, or they may sign themselves in with a note.
- Discretionary / Extended Absence forms are available online and in the GMS Student Services Office. We cannot excuse more than 3 days per year.



HOW CAN I BEST SUPPORT MY CHILD?

- Ensure regular attendance
- Establish daily homework routines
- Review the agenda book regularly
- Each week, review class grades with your child using Canvas
- Contact the teacher
- Attend teacher conferences
- Trust, but verify! (Use the 24- hour rule!;)

- Be sure to monitor any accounts your child is using.




Students <u>CAN</u> face disciplinary consequences for social media posts that cause disruption to normal school operations.





Use the "24-hour Rule"

Normal Peer Conflicts vs. Bullying

- ★ Equal social power or friends
- ★ Happens occasionally/accidentally
- ★ Not serious
- ★ Equal emotional reaction
- Not seeking power/attention/control
- ★ Not trying to get something or coerce
- ★ Remorse- takes responsibility
- ★ Desire to solve the problem/repair the relationship

- Imbalance of power/not friends
- → Repeated negative actions/words
- Purposeful
- → May involve serious threat or physical/emotional harm
- → Strong emotional reaction from victim, little/none from aggressor
- Aggressor seeks to gain power, control, possession
- → No remorse- blames victim
- → No effort/desire to resolve/repair
