- Lockers are narrow.
- No wheels on backpacks.



Students may carry a <u>small</u> purse/fanny pack/"everywhere belt bag" for small personal items (no string bags).

These items should be kept inside of desks in the classroom.

Electronics

Cell Phones & Smart Watches:

Personal communication devices like <u>cell</u> <u>phones</u> need to be on "off and away all day" which means off/silent and out of sight. This includes lunch, recess, hallways and bathrooms. <u>Smart watches</u> should be on "focus" mode or "do not disturb".





Laptops:

All students will use their Chromebooks for instruction during the school day.


