OVERVIEW. Intramurals will be offered for three nine-week sessions during the 2018-2019 school year. **Program times and dates will vary,** so please pay careful attention to program specifics when signing up in order to ensure the program times and days fit your schedule.

TRANSPORTATION. All students participating in intramurals need to prearrange their own transportation home from the intramural. If a student is continually picked up late from a session, they may not be allowed to continue participating in intramurals. You do not need to send in a note granting permission for your child to stay after school on the days they are signed up for an intramural. You may choose to allow your child to walk to the Glenwood Library/Glenwood Community Center after intramurals if pickup does not work for your family. Students may ride home with another parent if they have written permission from their parent/guardian.

OTHER INTRAMURAL POLICIES. Intramural programs are not held on early dismissal days. Intramurals may be cancelled based on enrollment. Cancellations may also occur due to inclement weather or unavoidable emergencies. Any change in the schedule will be announced in advance during the school day. Due to this possibility, please make sure your child knows what plans he/she should follow to get home in case a cancellation occurs. Students should dress appropriately and are expected to follow school policies and procedures at all times. Program space is limited, and enrollment is mostly on a first come, first served basis (see program for details).

This ensemble will be an auditioned a capella choir, named "Bellas & Fellas," who will perform one or two pieces at the Spring Chorus Concert on May 30th, 2019 at 7pm at Glenelg High School. I am looking for 20 singers that are dedicated and would like the additional training that singing in a small auditioned group will provide. You do not need to currently be a member of the GMS Chorus/Choir to audition for this ensemble. Students will need to audition and should see Mrs. Johnson before March 11th to get audition requirements and set up a time to sing for her.
