We view the code of conduct as a team effort. There are responsibilities for staff, students, families, and our community. Let's all do our part to make this year safe and successful for all!







#### Lockers

- Arrival
- Before Lunch
- After Lunch
- Dismissal
- Other times?Ask a teacher for a pass



- <u>Backpacks</u>: Kids may carry them to classes, but not lunch
- <u>Lunch</u>: Backpacks must remain in lockers
- Lockers are <u>narrow</u>!
- No wheels on backpacks
- Suggestions:
  - Arrival: We encourage students to take what they need for morning classes only
  - After lunch: We encourage students to take what they need for afternoon classes only.

## Laptops


All students will use their Chromebooks for instruction during the school day.

- In accordance with Policy 8020: Secondary Grading and Reporting, all asynchronous day assignments must be completed within 10 days.


